


- **8.** The LORD turns his eyes to *the* just, And his ears are open *to* their cry. The LORD turns his face against *the* wicked To destroy their remembrance *from* the earth.
- **9.** When the just cry out, the *LORD* hears, And rescues them in all *their* distress. The LORD is close to the bro-*ken*-hearted; Those whose spirit is crushed *he* will save.
- **10.** Many are the trials of *the* just man, But from them all the LORD will *res*-cue him. He will keep guard over all *his* bones; Not one of his bones *shall* be broken.
- **11.** Evil brings death to *the* wicked; Those who hate the just *man* are doomed. The LORD ransoms the souls of *his* servants. All who trust in him shall not *be* condemned.
