Psalm 34: 2-3,4-5,6-7,8-9,10-11,12-13,14-15,16-17,18-19,20-21,22-23

- 1. I will bless the LORD *at* all times; Praise of him is always *in* my mouth. In the LORD my soul shall *make* its boast; The humble shall hear *and* be glad.
- Glorify the LORD with me;
 Together let us praise his name.
 I sought the LORD, and he an-swered me;
 From all my terrors he set me free.
- 3. Look toward him *and* be radiant; Let your faces not *be* abashed. This lowly one called; *the* LORD heard, And rescued him from all *his* distress.
- **4.** The angel of the LORD *is* encamped Around those who fear *him*, to rescue them. Taste and see that the *LORD* is good. Blessed the man who seeks ref-*uge* in him.
- 5. Fear the LORD, you his holy ones. They lack nothing, those who fear him. The rich suffer want and go hungry, But those who seek the LORD lack no blessing.
- **6.** Come chil-*dren*, and hear me, That I may teach you the fear *of* the LORD. Who is it that *de*-sires life And longs to see pros-*per*-ous days?

- 7. Guard your *tongue* from evil, And your lips from speak-*ing* deceit. Turn aside from evil *and* do good. Seek after peace, *and* pursue it.
- **8.** The LORD turns his eyes *to* the just, And his ears are open *to* their cry. The LORD turns his face ag-*ainst* the wicked To destroy their remembrance *from* the earth.
- **9.** When the just cry out, *the* LORD hears, And rescues them in all *their* distress. The LORD is close to the *bro*-kenhearted; Those whose spirit is crushed *he* will save.
- **10.** Many are the trials *of* the just man, But from them all the LORD will *res*-cue him. He will keep guard over *all* his bones; Not one of his bones *shall* be broken.
- **11.** Evil brings death *to* the wicked; Those who hate the just *man* are doomed. The LORD ransoms the souls *of* his servants. All who trust in him shall not *be* condemned.
